

Jo Morton June 10 All-Day Workshop – Starry Night

Supplies for “Starry Night” Workshop

Sewing Machine in good working order with a $\frac{1}{4}$ ” foot -- Bring your good sewing machine, the one you usually sew on and do your best work on)

Scissors, Pins, Seam Ripper, Extra Needle for Machine, Wound Bobbins

Ott Light (Optional, you may want additional light, depends upon the class room lighting)

Thread – 100% cotton thread like DMC 50 wt, Mettler 60/2 or Mettler Silk Finish in a dark neutral shade like medium brown or even black (white/ecru shows in the seams)

Rotary cutter (with good blade) and small rulers (4” x 4” or 6” x 6” Omnigrid ruler with the $\frac{1}{8}$ ” grid, and 6” x 12” suggested sizes) – we will be cutting smaller pieces and 24” rulers are overkill and take too much room.

Small cutting mat or several large cutting mats to be shared.
