

## Jo Morton June 9 Afternoon Workshop – Hand Pieced LeMoyne Star

### Supplies for “Hand Pieced LeMoyne Star

Basic sewing supplies to include scissors, pins, and thimble, and needle threader

Ott light - optional (You may want more light for hand work)

Mechanical lead pencil (I like a .9 mm – yes, it is fatter but it glides over the fabric weave nicely)

Rotary cutter

Small ruler (4” x 4” or 6” x 6” is nice)

Small mat 12” x 18” is good

Thread – neutral color like tan or taupe, suggest DMC 50wt, Mettler 60/2, or Mettler 50/3.

Optional – “Thread Heaven”, silicone thread conditioner.

Fabric – Pre-wash (I prefer to use pre-washed fabrics for handwork)

Small pieces of two different red prints for star piecing

Fat quarter of green print for saw tooth border piecing

Small piece of another green print for center star

Small pieces of three different gold/mustard prints

Fat quarter of striped fabric (or something you like) for alternate block and saw tooth border piecing.

Small pieces or fat quarter of tone on tone for stars background or substitute colors to your liking.
